The term ahead promises a lot. Aside from making sure everyone continues to progress with their learning in maths, reading and writing and the other subject areas, there are a range of important school activities and events.

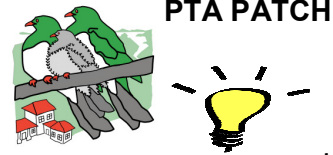
